

QUALIFICATION OUTLINE **CUA51020 DIPLOMA OF SCREEN AND MEDIA** **(Specialist make-up services)**

At the completion of this qualification, the individual will be competent in a broad range of specialised technical skills and practical applications in the field of make-up and/or hair stylist designer for the film, television, and entertainment industries. For those already in employment this course will provide the benchmark concepts and up-skill their knowledge to current day practices for make-up work alone or assists in coordinating projects within a team environment. To achieve the Diploma of Screen and Media, all 15 units must be completed.
